CLASS 1: RED & GREEN - Main subject must be red and green.

CLASS 2: MACRO/ CLOSEUP - Open subject.

CLASS 3: ARCHITECTURE

CLASS 4: OUR AMAZING PETS

CLASS 5: RURAL LIFE IN WA

CLASS 6: AUSTRALIAN NATIVE FLORA

CLASS 7: AUSTRALIAN NATIVE FAUNA

CLASS 8: CREATIVE - Must not be AI generated.

Monochrome - Black and white

CLASS 9: PORTRAIT - one or more person(s).

CLASS 10: INDUSTRY IN WA

Up to 3 photos of any subject

CLASS 12: HIGH SCHOOL - Open subject.

Up to 3 photos of any subject

Prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be awarded for all classes.

Conditions of Entry

- i. Competition is open to all photographers who do not earn a majority of income through photography.
- ii. No limit on entries. Up to 3 photos per class. \$3.00 per entry, payable at time of entry via EFT to BSB 066-517, Account # 10175912. Classes 11 and 12 are free to enter.
- iii. Entries must be the original work of the entrant taken within the previous two years and must not have won prizes in any other Competition before.
- iv. A photograph may be entered into one class only.
- v. Manjimup Photo Club may disqualify any photograph that is discriminatory, offensive, or that fails to meet either the Conditions of Entry or Display Standards.
- vi. Judging will be conducted by independent judges selected by Manjimup Photo Club. Their decision is final and no appeal will be entered into.
- vii. Though all reasonable care will be taken, Manjimup Photo Club will not be held responsible for any damage to any photos entered.
- viii. Entries must be in no later than 5pm Monday, 9th December 2024. You may drop them off at the Manjimup Community Resource Centre or post to 45 Rose St, Manjimup WA 6258
- ix. Non Club Members can enter all classes excluding class 11 and 12, which are free to all school children.

Display Standards

- i. Photographs must be no larger than A4, Matted size must be 355mm x275mm. (5mm variance allowed) and no thicker than 5mm to fit into the hanging clips.
- ii. All entries must have the entrant's full name, phone number and class number on the back top left corner.
- iii. If mounting photos on card, we strongly recommend using double-sided tape instead of glue; on a hot day, glue will buckle the photos. (For Classes 11 and 12 only).
- iv. Mats to be black or white only.
- v. Note Categories 1 through to 10 must be matted.
- vi. Mats can be purchased from Manjimup Community Resource Centre for \$10.00 Each.
